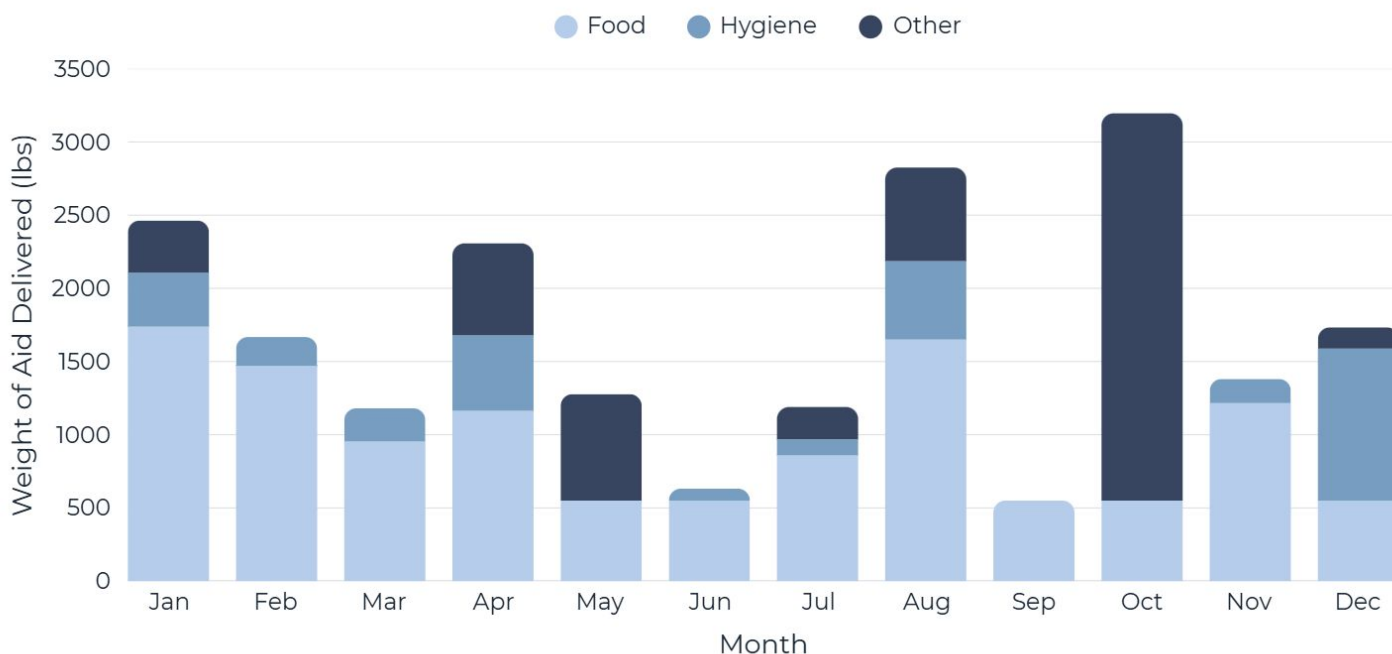

Note from the Board



To Our Valued Donors, Partners, and Stakeholders,

At the beginning of 2025, Dignity Aid International was a small network of volunteers which had just received its registration in the United States, was constantly moving offices, and had just one main program (the Targeted Village Distributions). By the end of 2025, we had doubled our number of volunteers hosted, rented a central office location in Odesa, and were close to adding a second program (Internally Displaced Persons Family Support, which began in early 2026). Donations, which in 2024 totaled under \$13,000, increased to more than \$35,000 in 2025.

Your generosity and support have made that growth possible. Thank you.

Our goals for 2026 are ambitious. Having received all of our donations from small private donors so far, we are putting in extra effort to actively seek grants from small foundations and grant-giving institutions which can support us in the range of \$5,000-\$10,000 (or 1-2k per month). We are also expanding both our village and our IDP programs while continuing our support for local volunteer projects such as the psychiatric hospital and mental health support groups. And we'd like to achieve that growth in a way that is sustainable for volunteers, staff, and donors.

It's a tall order. We will remain flexible, as the vagaries of war and of the international economy buffet us all. Our focus will continue to be on the dignity of beneficiaries first and foremost. In 2025, we achieved great things within those parameters. With hard work and with your continued support, 2026 will be even more successful.

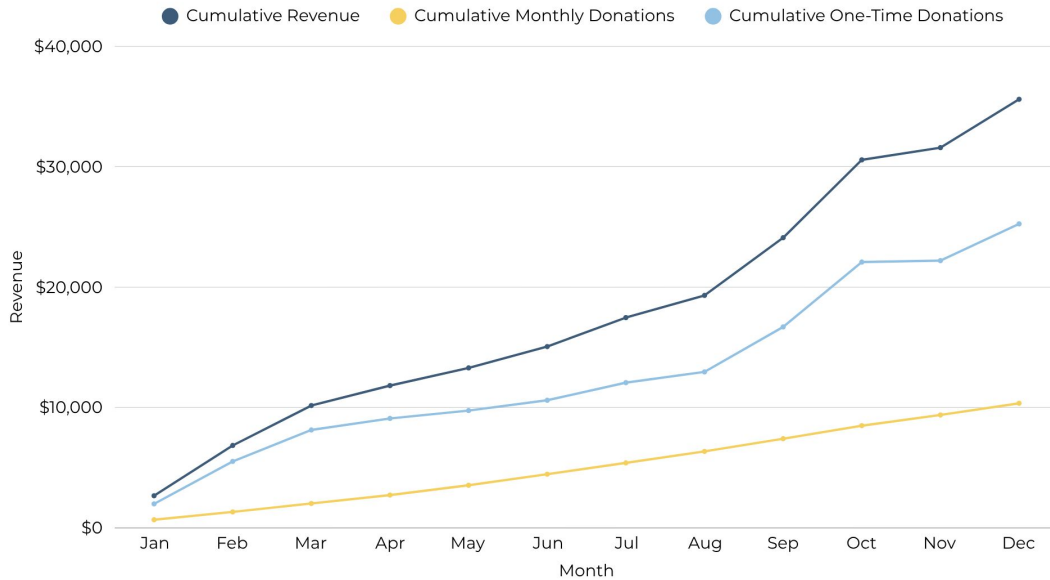

Revenue



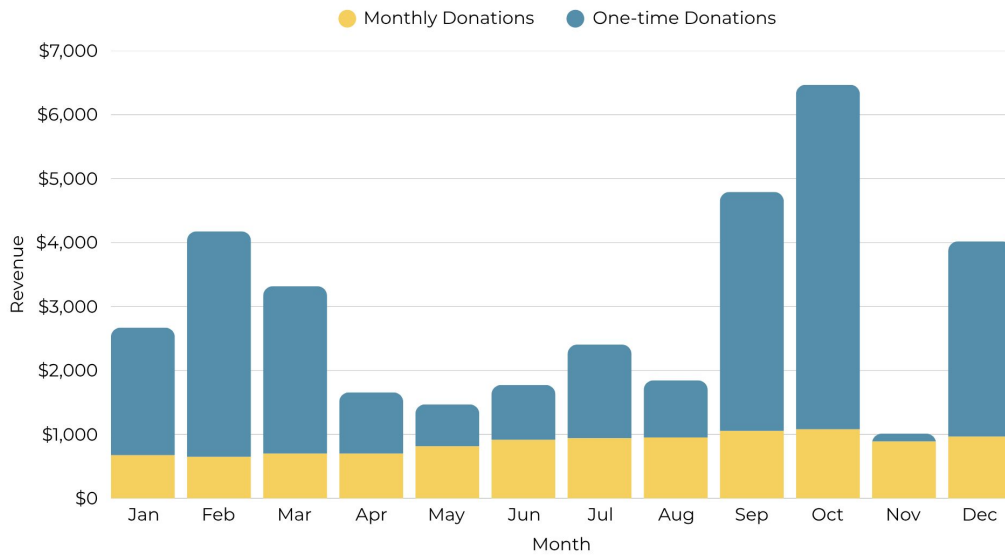
Cumulative Revenue

Monthly donations rose from about \$700 per month at the beginning of 2025 to about \$1,000 per month at the end of the year. One-time donations were helped by fundraisers at the beginning of the year (Feb/Mar) and in the fall (Sep/Oct), with our monthly donors providing stability in between:



Average Donation Size

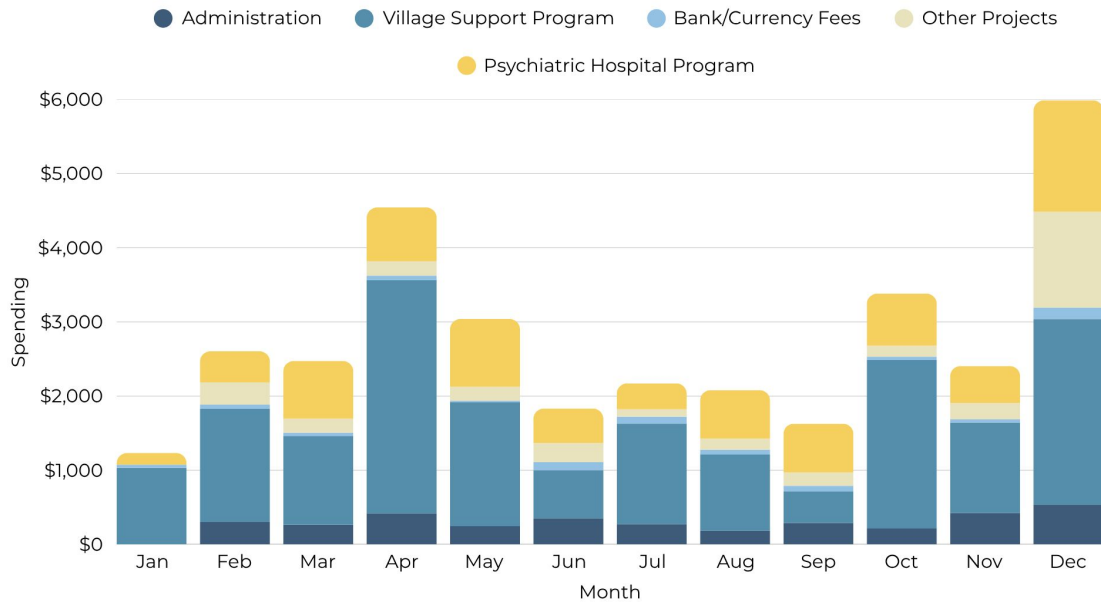

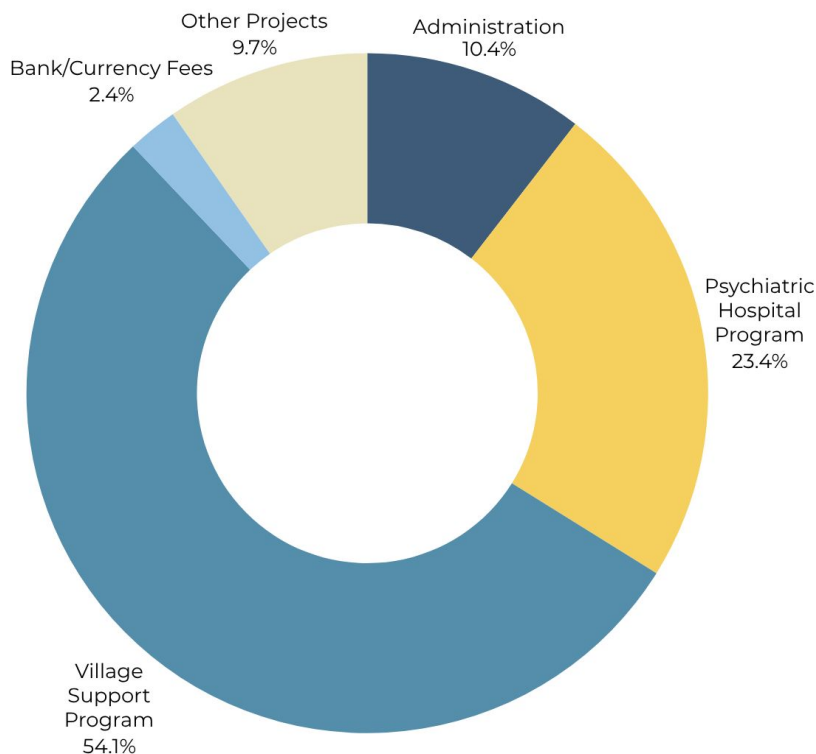
Monthly Expenses

Annual Expenses by Program Area

In 2025, 77.5% of Dignity Aid expenses went to village support and psychiatric hospital programs. The remaining 9.7% was spent on other projects, leaving a total of 12.8% for administrative costs and bank/currency fees combined, which meets our goal of staying under the commonly accepted benchmark of 15% or less for administrative costs.
